Our application for a conservation grant has been successful with recent notification that €25,000 has been approved by the Minister for Arts and Heritage, Mr Jimmy Deenihan. This has come about mainly by Catherine Byrne's persistent calls to the Ministers office, which is greatly appreciated. A number of terms and conditions must be strictly adhered to, primarily that the funding be used for external structural repairs. This work will commence shortly.
