

## 8th February 2015 5th Sunday of the Year

In Mark's Gospel from where the Sunday readings of this year are taken, one cannot but be struck by the compassion of Jesus. For Him every individual person has an innate and undeniable human dignity. Sunday, 8th February has been declared:

## International Day of Prayer against Human Trafficking.

**Fact:** 21 million people, often the poorest and most vulnerable are victims of trafficking for sexual exploitation, forced labour, illegal organ removal, domes tic servitude and forced marriages, suffering abuse and unspeakable violence.

**Fact:** For traffickers and pimps, this is one of the most lucrative illegal activities, generating 32 billion dollars a year. It is the 3rd most profitable 'business' after drugs and arms trafficking.

The primary objectives of the International Day are to create greater awareness of this modern form of slavery; to reflect on the overall situation of violence and injustice that affect so many voiceless people, and to seek out individuals or groups campaigning for an end to the **evil of human trafficking** 

Let us also remember and pray for the hundreds of young girls abducted and enslaved in Nigeria. Their plight was a sensation last year with worldwide pleas for their release. However their whereabouts remain unknown while global outrage now directs itself elsewhere.

'O God, when we hear of children and adults deceived and taken to unknown places for purposes of exploitation, forced labour and organ 'harvesting', our hearts are saddened and our spirits angry that their dignity and rights are ignored through threats, lies and force. We cry out against the evil practice of this modern slavery, and pray with St Bakhita for it to end. Give us wisdom and courage to reach out and stand with those whose bodies, hearts and spirits have been so wounded, so that together we may make real your promises to fill these sisters and brothers with a love that is tender and good. Send the exploiters away empty-handed to be converted from this wickedness, and help us all to claim the freedom that is your gift to your children. 'Amen

*'slaves no more, but sisters and brothers'* 8th February is the feast day of St Josephine Bakhita, a survivor of human trafficking, canonized in 2000.

### Diocesan Reflection Process in preparation for the 2015 Synod of Bishops

The Diocese has proposed that each parish engage in a reflective process on the subject of the challenges of family life in today's world. The response of each parish is to be submitted by the end of March. To help in responding to this invitation, Fr Des O'Donnell OMI will facilitate a meeting of the 3 Oblate parishes in the coming weeks.

Worldwide, there is great appreciation of the fact that Pope Francis is eager to hear the views of the people on the theme of the Synod which will reflect on how support services on family life can be strengthened and renewed.
