Gospel Mk4: 26-34

'The kingdom of God is like a mustard seed, the smallest of all seeds'

How can something as small and insignificant illustrate the kingdom of God? When we think of a tiny seed growing into a tree providing shelter and shade, it awakens us to the image of God's kingdom as a place of safety and refuge. The mustard seed symbolises small beginnings and how great things can result from some of the smallest and (what appear to be) insignificant acts.
