The liturgy of 3rd/4th October will celebrate in a special way the gift of Creation. On this week-end, we will welcome Colm Hogan from Trocaire who will speak on a topic of worldwide concern-Climate Justice. Changing weather patterns, as a result of climate change increase the risk of crop failure: the effect of a bad harvest in one part of the world can have dramatic impact elsewhere particularly in developing countries.


