

Gospel (Lk15: 1-32)

The story of the Prodigal Son, one of the best known of all parables, has been retold time and again both in the form of art and literature. Rembrandt and Shakespeare both have drawn inspiration from this well known parable. Henry Nouwen, author and theologian was so moved by Rembrandt's famous painting that he wrote a best seller '*The Return of the Prodigal—The Story of Homecoming'*, He writes '*I can now see the hands that forgive, console. heal and offer a festive meal must now become my hands*. Unconditional love, being welcomed as well as welcoming, being host as well as guest, celebrating and being celebrated: a multi layered story that we can all relate to.

Creation Time is celebrated by churches world wide at this time of year. It is a time to give thanks and reflect on the wonder, beauty and mystery of God's creation.
