Inchicore Regeneration Information Meetings

There was general agreement that the 1st of the public consultation meetings was a worthwhile exercise giving residents' an opportunity to voice their views and concerns regarding the proposed plan for the area. To a full house in Richmond Barracks, the Project Manager and other Dublin City Council staff outlined plans , not alone for the area of the former St Michael's Est. but also for the wider area.

Concerns were raised regarding the density of the proposed dwellings, the lack of services & amenities with the present level of crime and antisocial activity in the area foremost in the topics raised. The failing of management companies to address present problems is an issue that was also raised.

Two more public consultation meetings will follow. On 19th November, the Businesses of the area will meet with D.C.C. and on the following week 26th, Community Groups will have their opportunity to voice their views and concerns.

It's desirable that the community engage with this process so that working together and along with the Statutory bodies, we bring about a united, healthy and socially inclusive community as we go forward into the future.
